

10. Complaints regarding cabana use: Alika was contacted with a concern about people not cleaning up after renting the cabana for parties. One homeowner suggested a contract be signed by those renting the space that it will be cleaned appropriately after use. As the reservation contact for the cabana rentals, Alika does inform people by phone/email of the responsibilities of taking care of the space and will continue to do so.
11. Complaints regarding boats left at the park: There have been concerns raised about the number of kayaks and canoes that are being left at the park this summer. As of this date, there are several still stored at the park lakefront. This has become an issue at times for residents trying to access the boat launch boats to the left of the dock. The board will include a message in the next newsletter asking residents to remove their boats from the park by October 1st.
12. Newsletter: to go out prior to October 1st. It will include the request for boats to be removed and announcement of the Fall clean-up and BBQ. Diana and Silke will follow-up.
13. Cabana: The cabana needs new railing and flooring, as well as electrical inspected. The board will seek 3 bids to have this work done (Alika to follow-up), as well as have the electrical checked (Diana to follow-up).
14. Annual Homeowners meeting: The board hopes to get the meeting scheduled at the Woodinville Library for Sunday, January 21st at 2pm, depending on availability. Topics of discussion may include increasing dues to address cabana improvements and maintenance; updating bylaws regarding the price of keys and cabana rental; adding a board position for communications (for website, etc.).
